The risk management committee continues to pursue its purpose and mission of identifying current or potential hazards (possible causes of loss or liability) in the physical plant and the operations of the church, and recommending measures to eliminate or mitigate such hazards. This is understood to include, but not be limited to, areas such as accident prevention, fire prevention, childcare, transportation dangers, finances/payroll safeguards, volunteer selection & training, employment practices and overall policies and procedures, as the foregoing relate to all operations of the church and its physical plant.

During the year 2011, the committee was successful (thanks to the Endowment Committee) in placing four wireless security cameras in the sanctuary building. Last spring, the security cameras in the office area were instrumental in the arrest and conviction of the person responsible for stealing Pastor James's laptop and other personal items from his office during the church service. Even though the perpetrator was convicted, there was still a financial loss to pastor James, personally, and to the church. This has resulted in a heightened sense of awareness, as you may have noticed, around the office, especially during church services.

The committee continues to meet regularly to address concerns as they are communicated by church members and staff.
